SUBJECT: Expanded Definition of Rape

**REPORTING ALERT:
MODIFICATIONS FOR REPORTING
OF THE EXPANDED RAPE CATEGORY**

In January 2012, the FBI announced a new expanded definition for the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) offense of rape. This modification will impact New York's Crime Reporting Program. A large number of sexual assaults will now be reported as violent Index crimes.

How does the expanded definition differ from the historical definition of rape?

The historical UCR definition of rape only included female victims penetrated vaginally by a male. This definition has been in place since 1929 and includes only a limited number of New York's Penal Law crimes. The expanded UCR definition of rape encompasses additional offenses and is defined as follows:

“Penetration, no matter how slight, of the vagina or anus with any body part or object, or oral penetration by a sex organ of another person, without the consent of the victim.”

For UCR reporting purposes, this new definition includes male and female victims, all anal and vaginal sex acts, and any oral sex act that involves another person's sexual organs.

How will this new definition affect New York State crime statistics?

The expanded definition will require DCJS to re-classify the UCR offense code for 14 Article 130 Penal Laws that would have previously been reported as a Part II UCR offense of “Sex Offense”. These crimes are listed in Attachment A. Analysis has shown that the following crimes will have the greatest impact:

- PL 130.20.01 – Sexual misconduct: Sexual intercourse without victim's consent.
- PL 130.25.02 – Rape 3rd degree: Offender 21 or older and victim less than 17.
- PL 130.30.01 – Rape 2nd degree: Offender 18 or older and victim less than 15.
- PL 130.50 – Criminal sexual act 1st degree: Oral sexual conduct or anal sexual conduct by force or lack of consent.

Will this change mislead the public when it appears that the number of reported of rapes have increased?

DCJS will ensure that state and local crime data are presented in a manner that allows for an objective historical comparison. The expanded definition of rape is intended to show a more accurate count of sexual assaults involving penetration.

How will DCJS modify the New York State Crime Reporting Program to account for this change?

DCJS will be collecting two distinct subsets of the newly expanded rape crime category. The first subset will only contain those Penal Laws that have historically been defined as rape. These Penal Laws will be reported under the current offense category labeled “Forcible Rape”, which will be renamed “Rape (Pre 2013)”. The second subset will only contain those Penal Laws that would not have been reported as rape prior to the definitional change. For these Penal Laws, a new offense category entitled “Rape (2013 Expanded)” will be created. The combined total of these two subsets will represent your agency’s total number of reported rapes (as defined by the 2013 expanded federal definition).

Does this new crime category affect the UCR hierarchy rules for reporting crime?

Yes: The new crime category will require some programming changes to meet the Federal UCR hierarchy rules. In multiple-offense incidents, the number of victims associated with either “Rape (2013 Expanded)” or “Rape (Pre 2013)” will be scored as the top charge unless the other offense is a homicide or negligent manslaughter. However, if a single victim is associated with the offenses of “Rape (2013 Expanded)” and “Rape (Pre 2013)”, then the victim count must be scored under the crime category of “Rape (Pre 2013)”.

How will this affect the New York State Coded Law File?

The New York State Coded Law File will be updated to support the new “Rape (2013 Expanded)” crime category. In January 2013, DCJS will be releasing an updated version of the Coded Law File, which will consist of the new UCR code for “Rape (2013 Expanded)”. While no new Penal Laws are being added for this change, a significant number of Penal Laws currently coded as “Sex Offense” (UCR code 22) will have the new UCR code of 50 for “Rape (2013 Expanded)”.

What changes are required by local reporting agencies?

Incident-Based Reporting (IBR) agencies will not have to make modifications to their IBR submission files, but are required to update their local version of the New York State Coded Law file to ensure compliance with this new reporting requirement.

Summary based reporting (Traditional UCR) agencies will have to take several steps to ensure compliance with this new reporting requirement.

1. Reporting agencies that generate monthly crime reports from their Records Management System (RMS) will be required to make programming modifications that will recognize and categorize those Penal Laws that have been re-coded as “Rape (2013 Expanded)” (UCR Code 50).

2. The RMS generated reports must be re-formatted to incorporate the new summary counts for “Rape (2013 Expanded)” offenses and Rape (2013 Expanded)” arrests of persons under 18 and persons over 18. Required data fields and a suggested format can be found highlighted on Attachment B.
3. Reporting agency’s local version of the New York State Coded Laws must be updated.

Note: Summary agencies that complete monthly reports by hand will need to download the newest version of the UCR Return A and Arrest reporting forms. These reports will be made available in January 2013 at the following link:

When will these changes take effect?

Reporting agencies must have all required changes ready to be implemented with the release of the updated Coded Law File in January 2013. This will ensure that the local RMS is able to categorize those Penal Laws that have been re-coded as a UCR offense of “Rape (2013 Expanded)”.
