New York City 2009 data appears in a temporary format while NYPD's Uniform Crime Reports are being developed. While the rest of the state uses the UCR crime categories of "aggravated assault" and "simple assault", NYC data instead shows the categories of "felonious assault" and "assault third degree & related offenses". The statistical tabulations presented for New York City are derived from the top charge of the reported complaint and the relationship/intimate partner information collected by the NYPD crime reporting system. The expanded definition of intimate partner was not implemented into the NYPD's crime reporting system until April 2009. Prior to April, reported intimate partner victims were limited to spouse and ex-spouse and a child in common.

Felony Assault – Includes felony assaults as defined by Article 120 of the New York State Penal Law.

Assault 3 & Related Offenses – Includes all non-felony assaults as defined by Article 120 of the New York State Penal Law.
